Stalls must be cancelled 96 hrs. prior to start of show. Person making reservations will be billed for stalls not cancelled in time.

It's highly recommended that you be pre-order shavings, and they will be at your stall waiting. If you pre-order shavings and don't cancel them you will be charged for them.

Show Rules:

Combining or canceling of classes is done in accordance with APHA & PHBA rules. If there are less than 3 entries in the class, show management reserves the right to cancel any class. Any act of discourtesy to the judge and/or show officials will disqualify horse/rider. All entry fees will be forfeited. The judge's decision is final. The APHA/PHBA &/or ESPHC, nor the Chemung Co. Fairgrounds, will be responsible for any accident to horse and/or rider.

Make checks payable to ESPHC – any show bills not paid in full within 30 days will be charged a \$10 late fee, paid in 60 days a \$20 late fee and 90 days a \$30 late fee. A \$25.00 service charge will be added every time the bank returns a check.

There will be weekend high points in every division for APHA, and PHBA as long as you showed in at least 3 classes per division.
