

MAIL IN BID FORM FOR ESPHC BFPF/SSA 2010

If you want to bid on a stallions service to be auctioned, but cannot attend the auction, then you can fill out the bid coupon and enclose check for the BFPF service fee and mail to Ken and Sandy Cobb, PO Box 139, McDonough, New York 13801

You can also give the chairperson authority to increase your minimum bid at the auction. To do so you must indicate your maximum bid on the mail in bid form and sign it. You will be notified if your bid was/was not successful. If your bid was successful you will have 7 days, from notification, to forward the remaining balance. Failure to remit balance in 7 days will mean automatic forfeit of your bid. If your bid was not successful your check will be returned.

All parties (who wish to be) will be contacted about raising their bid. The high bidder will be awarded the stallions service at the auction.
