



COVID PROTOCOLS

The following guidelines have been put in place in accordance with the recommendations of the CDC, WHO and New York State regarding social distancing and public Health. Exhibitors are asked to refrain from attending the show if they have been in contact with anyone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days, have a fever or other symptoms.

- Social Distancing (6 feet between individuals) will be adhered to at all times on the grounds and people shall not congregate in groups larger than 10 people.
- In accordance with New York State executive orders, all individuals, including staff and officials, must wear a mask or face covering when social distancing is not possible, except when mounted.
- All staff will have their temperatures checked before beginning work. Any staff member with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be sent home.
- All individuals entering the grounds should monitor their temperature daily and should not enter if presenting with a temperature of 100.4 or higher.
- No outside spectators. Exhibitors are encouraged to limit the number of people in their group.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the grounds.
- Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized with outer doors left open.
- Show Office will be limited to one person in the building at a time. Pre entries are strongly encouraged to limit traffic in the office. Class adds/scratches may be texted to show secretary at 315-725-0346. **Please include a copy of APHA membership (Youth, Nov/Amateur), registration papers, coggins, rabies, etc. with your entry. All entries should be emailed to: horseshowentries2021@gmail.com**
- Show office personnel will have a protective barrier separating them from exhibitors
- Show office will provide hand sanitizer and will sanitize pens and high touch areas regularly. When possible, doors will be left open during check-in or periods of high traffic.
- Arena entrance/exits will be arranged so that riders are not coming in close contact.
- No loitering at the gate – exhibitors should pick up prizes at exit.
- Access to stabling should be limited to essential personal and masks should be worn in the aisles whenever more than 2 people are present (that are not within families that live together).
- RV hookups shall be parked so that social distancing between trailers can be maintained.

Failure to adhere to any of the protocols will result in forfeiture of any fees associated with The Yankee Union and will result in removal off the grounds.
